### To be a Paid-On-Call Firefighter...

Several steps are required for all candidates to become a firefighter with the Town of Menasha, including the following eligibility requirements:

- You must be at least 18 years of age;
- You must be a high school graduate (or equivalent);
- You must possess a valid Wisconsin driver's license;
- You must live within two miles of the Town border



### The Process...

Further candidate screening will be used to evaluate abilities as they relate to firefighter performance. Candidates will:

- Complete an employment application
- Attend an informational orientation
- Participate in a physical agility test
- Interview with department members
- Clear a background investigation
- Participate in a medical exam/drug test
- Interview with the Fire Chief
